Alexa, you can make calls, ask to play music, hear the news, check weather, control smart home devices, and more.

To get started, follow the steps below once you've linked your handset with your hub.



## Setting up and using Amazon Alexa is easy

Press the **Alexa button** on your handset:



Visit https://amazon.com/gb/code on a laptop, smartphone or tablet, and sign-in using your existing Amazon account, or create a new one.





When prompted, enter the code shown on your handset to register the device:





Finish following on-screen prompts until you see 'Alexa setup is now complete' on your handset.





Make sure you check the "Contacts for Alexa Communication" box on the set up screen so you can use Alexa to call your contacts by name.





## Discover Alexa on your BT Advanced Digital Home Phone

With Alexa, you can ask to play music, hear the news, check weather, control smart home devices, and more. Alexa lives in the cloud, so it's always getting smarter, adding new capabilities that are delivered to your device automatically. Using Alexa on your BT Advanced Digital Home Phone is simple – just tap-and-ask, and Alexa will respond instantly."

"Remind me to water the plants."

## Make a call with Alexa

To make a call using your voice, first add your contacts on your BT Advanced Digital Home Phone.

You can then call any of your contacts by pressing the Alexa button and saying "Call..." followed by the assigned contact name.

"Call Mum."

"Call Steve."

You can also dial any number using your voice. Just press the Alexa button and say:

"Call 07123456789."
